**Al-driven data modelling** can support more resilient infrastructure designs.

**Remote sensing** can enhance environmental management and climate resilience.

**Automated AI Driven misinformation monitoring** is already helping the Authority stay attuned to public sentiment and swiftly correct inaccuracies.

Beyond technology, we underscored our strong belief in empowering youth, women in engineering, and underrepresented voices in tech. The sponsorship of the summit is a commitment to creating pathways for future leaders who will continue to innovate and improve Lesotho's development landscape.
