

# Construction Progress Update: Mabunyaneng and Khubelu Bridges



The Lesotho Highlands Development Authority (LHDA) is pleased to share significant progress on the construction of the Mabunyaneng and Khubelu bridges. The works, overseen by Zutari and executed by the Concor – Nthane Brothers Joint Venture, continue to advance steadily and in line with the project schedule.

Road works in the project area are progressing exceptionally well. Overall fill works have reached 90% completion, while subsoil drainage stands at 82%, marking strong strides in establishing durable and climate-resilient road foundations. Construction works of the realignment road along the A1 Road also reflect commendable progress, with the roadbed now 97% complete. Further developments include the Lower Selected Subgrade at 45% and the Upper Selected Subgrade at 43%, indicating ongoing structural buildup toward full road functionality.

A major highlight is the Mechanically Stabilised Earth (MSE) Wall, which is now 98% complete. Backfilling and panel installations are nearing finalisation across several segments. This engineering marvel plays a critical role in ensuring overall structural integrity while at the same time allowing smooth and safe traffic flow between Mapholaneng and Mokhotlong, during construction.

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
